- **Flying session :-** A flying session with an Air Squadron NCC unit is the ultimate highlight for Air Wing cadets. It transitions classroom theory into actual stick-and-rudder experience, usually featuring Virus SW-80 microlight aircraft

- **Tent pitching :-** Tent pitching is one of the most physically demanding, highly coordinated team events in NCC training. Whether practiced during institutional training, annual camps, or as preparation for national-level selections like the Vayu Sainik Camp (VSC)

- **Drill and Parade :** Emphasis was placed on drill practices to ensure precision and synchronization during parades. Cadets learned various commands and formations. These activities also foster teamwork and coordination among cadets.

➤ **Aeromodelling** : Practical sessions on aeromodelling were conducted to introduce cadets to aviation concepts and model building. There are quite a few variants of aeromodels, which are classified according to the role and utility of the type. These are static models, control line models and RC models.

➤ **i] Static**-These are the miniature replicas of original aircrafts. These are scaled models and are made with the high level of precision and perfection which requires high patience levels.

➤ **ii] Control Line**- The Control Line models are the type where the only one control surface is required i.e. rudder which is deflected to one side to balance the centrifugal force.

- **iii] Radio Control-** Radio Control models are the type which are controlled by installing the RC kit. The servos are fixed for the movement of the control surfaces. RC is highly maneuverable and performs loops.

- **Firing:** The firing session was a valuable and instructive experience for all involved. Under the guidance of our seasoned instructors, participants had the opportunity to enhance their marksmanship skills and deepen their understanding of firearm safety protocols. This activity instilled focus, discipline, and confidence—essential traits for every NCC cadet .

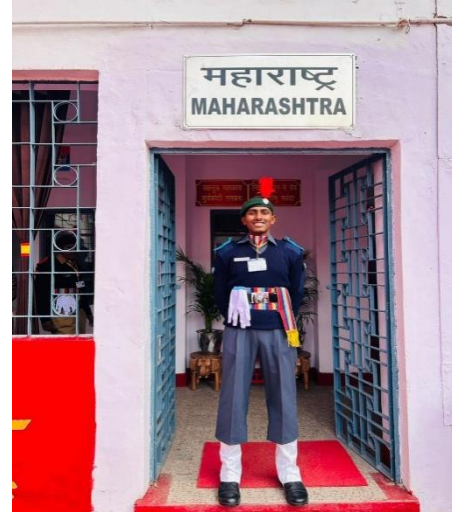
